Kenya — Mombasa to Thika

Dogo: a forward who came out of Mombasa Olympic and made her name at Thika Queens, topping the Kenyan league's scoring charts in their undefeated 2021 season.

Turkey

She captained Hakkarigücü in the Turkish Women's Super League and scored 23 goals there in 2023-24.

The United States and Denmark

In 2024 she became the first Kenyan woman to sign for and play in the NWSL, winning the Summer Cup with the Kansas City Current. A loan to HB Køge in Denmark turned permanent and brought the Danish Cup and the Danish championship, with European football alongside it.

Kenya

She captains the Harambee Starlets.

Vlatko Andonovski, the former United States women's national team head coach, signed her for the Kansas City Current in 2024, and she has since played under Kristian Mørch at HB Køge.

— Captain of the Kenya women's national team, she is the first Kenyan to play in the NWSL and won the 2024 NWSL x Liga MX Femenil Summer Cup with Kansas City Current.

Did you know

The first Kenyan woman in the NWSL — and a league and cup double in Denmark

Jereko, known as Dogo, captains the Harambee Starlets. She led the Kenyan league's scoring charts in Thika Queens' undefeated 2021 season, scored 23 goals in a single Turkish Super League campaign in 2023-24, and in 2024 became the first Kenyan woman to sign for and play in the NWSL, with the Kansas City Current, winning the Summer Cup with them. At HB Køge

she has since won the Danish Cup and the Danish championship, and played in Europe.

Did you know

Mombasa Olympic Ladies to the NWSL, and a Danish double

Born in Likoni, Mombasa, she started at Mombasa Olympic Ladies, joined Thika Queens in 2018 and finished as the Kenyan Women's Premier League's leading scorer in an unbeaten title season in 2021. Turkey came next — 11 goals in her first 17 games at Hakkariğücü, and the captaincy by 2023 — then in August 2024 she became the first Kenyan woman to sign in the NWSL, with the Kansas City Current, winning the NWSL x Liga MX Femenil Summer Cup. A loan to HB Køge became a permanent two-year deal in November 2025, and she has since won the Danish championship and Super Cup.

Did you know

She captains Kenya, and waited ten years for a tournament

She has led the Harambee Starlets since her senior debut in 2015, with nineteen international goals, and was named most valuable player at the 2026 Four Nations tournament in Zambia. The Starlets' return to WAFCON came a decade into her career — the clearest measure on this site of what the women's game has been asked to do without structure behind it.
