County Football Plan and Partnership

Find out what already exists in the county before proposing anything new, and agree who does what with the people who own the land.

The work

- Audit every playable pitch, school field and open space in Nyeri, with condition and access.
- Agree a memorandum with the county government and the FKF county branch.
- Publish a county football development plan with a five-year facility priority list.
- Map the demand: schools, existing weekend leagues, women's teams, refugee and disability groups.

What you end up with

- A published plan for Nyeri
- A signed county partnership
- A ranked facility priority list

How other professional clubs in the Premier League developed

In England no facility grant moves unless the project appears in the Local Football Facility Plan for that area. This step is that plan. — Football Foundation local facility planning: <https://footballfoundation.org.uk/looking-for-funding>

Constituted, Safeguarded and Accredited Clubs

Make the community clubs real organisations with adults accountable for children's safety.

The work

- Constitute and register about 16 community clubs with officers and bank accounts.
- Train and vet a safeguarding officer at every club, with a reporting route that works.
- Run an accreditation standard: constitution, safeguarding, coaching, first aid, insurance.
- Register every player and team on Kenya Connect.

What you end up with

- About 16 accredited clubs
- A safeguarding officer in every club
- Every player registered

Courts and Pitch Upgrades

Put surfaces on the ground that survive the rains and can be played on every day of the week.

The work

- Build 3 stackable five-a-side and futsal courts, fenced, floodlit and drained.
- Upgrade 1 community eleven-a-side ground with drainage, goals, line marking and changing provision.
- Train a local maintenance team during the build, not after it.

What you end up with

- 3 courts and 1 upgraded ground
- A 3.0:1 small-sided to full-size ratio
- A trained county maintenance team

What it costs in Nyeri

How other professional clubs in the Premier League developed

A full-size 3G pitch in England costs £800,000 to £1.5m with floodlights and groundworks, and takes a 16-week build. Kenya's cost base is a fraction of that. — Football Foundation AGP framework and costs: <https://footballfoundation.org.uk/looking-for-funding>

Leagues and Organised Competition

Give every team a fixture list, because unstructured football does not hold players.

The work

- Run about 6 divisions of twelve, home and away, for roughly 63 teams.
- Publish fixtures, results and tables so the season means something.
- Appoint referees to every fixture and run a discipline process.
- Add a girls' and women's division from the first season, not the third.

What you end up with

- 6 divisions of twelve
- 1,638 matches a year
- A published table and discipline record

Coaching, Refereeing and Volunteers

Train the adults. A court with no coach is a car park with lines on it.

The work

- Put 57 people through CAF and FKF entry coaching badges, weighted towards women.
- Run referee courses and mentor new officials through their first season.
- Train first aid and pitchside response at every club.
- Train groundskeeping so the surfaces last their design life.

What you end up with

- Badged coaches in every club
- Enough referees to cover the fixture list
- Trained groundstaff

Schools, Girls and Inclusion

Reach the children who will never walk into a club on their own.

The work

- Link every court to the schools within walking distance, with timetabled hours.
- Run a girls' league and reserve equal court hours for it.
- Run disability football and, where the county hosts camps, refugee sessions.
- Feed the orphans' and community programmes into the same fixture list.

What you end up with

- Timetabled school hours on every court
- A girls' league from season one
- Disability and refugee provision

What it costs in Nyeri

Girls' and women's league	Every year	\$11,000
Disability and refugee sessions	Every year	\$8,500

No one-off cost · every year \$33,500

How other professional clubs in the Premier League developed

Community use is a funding condition in England, not a nice-to-have. Same rule applies to every court proposed here. — England Football facilities and community use: <https://www.EnglandFootball.com/participate/leagues-and-clubs/Facilities-Guidance>

Talent Pathway Into The Professional Club

Connect the county's weekend football to the professional academy above it, so talent does not have to move to Nairobi at fourteen.

The work

- Run 1 county academy and coach-education centre as a centre of excellence.
- Hold open county trials on a published calendar, scouted against agreed criteria.
- Agree a written route into the professional club's 10–14 and 15–21 teams.
- Keep education in the deal: no player leaves school to chase a trial.

What you end up with

- 1 county academy
- A written route into the professional club
- Schooling kept in the pathway

What it costs in Nyeri

Trials, scouting and travel	Every year	\$12,500
Education support and tutoring	Every year	\$9,500

One-off \$52,800 · every year \$22,000

Operating Model and Maintenance

Pay for the upkeep out of the site's own income, so year six looks like year one.

The work

- Sell evening and weekend court hours at local prices, with subsidised school and girls' hours.
- Employ a county maintenance team across all the sites.
- Hold a sinking fund for surface replacement at the end of design life.
- Publish income against running cost every year for every site.

What you end up with

- Running costs covered by court income
- A funded replacement cycle
- Published site accounts
